Information We Collect:

We collect personal information such as your name, contact information, postal addresses, information regarding your employment history, current place of work, education history.

We may use this information, provided by you, in a variety of settings including:

- Communications such as fee reminders, IPANE or course invitations / reminders and service messages.
- To respond to questions or queries regarding the profession / employment / job advertisements.
- To inform you of PA research papers.
- To audit and protect the PA profession in Ireland, ensuring that all practicing PAs are listed on the MVR.
- For analytic purposes.

Your Rights:

- You have the right to access all information relating to you.
- You have the right to stop your data being processed.
- You have the right to have your data removed from the ISPA database.
